RE: Updates to Intravenous Immune Globulin (IVIG) and

Immune Globulin Screening Pilot (IGSP) Requests

DATE: September 28th 2016

Effective October 3rd 2016, in order to facilitate the Ministry of Health and Long-term Care (MOHLTC) IVIG form renewal process and IGSP form approval process, the clinical areas will access the patient's electronic health record to view the status of the IVIG request and the expiry date for a current acceptance on file.

To view, please follow the steps listed below.

For HHS Clinical Staff:


- 1. In Meditech PCI, select your patient
- 2. Down arrow (\downarrow) to access *Blood Bank Tests*, then right arrow (\rightarrow)
- 3. Down arrow (\downarrow) to view the IVIG EXPIRY. At this stage, the latest IVIG EXPIRY date will be listed to the right of the test name.
- 4. To view further information, right arrow (\rightarrow)
- Select the most recent 'test' result, then right arrow (→)
- 6. View report for IVIG EXPIRY information


For SJHH Clinical Staff:

- 1. In Physician Portal, select your patient
- 2. Click on the Results Tab
- 3. Look for IVIG EXPIRY. At this stage, the latest IVIG EXPIRY date will be listed to the right of the test name.
- 4. To view further information, click on the document icon
- 5. View report for IVIG EXPIRY information
